

## Donation Requirement

The Junior League of Wichita, Inc. requires every Active, Associate, Provisional and Transfer member to donate at least \$125 worth of merchandise by the end of each League year — June 30.

## Tax Deduction Guidelines

According to the IRS, contributions of clothing or household items must be in good used condition or better. Clothing or household items that do not meet this definition will not be accepted. A standard value list is provided inside this brochure to assist taxpayers in determining the value of their clothing and household donations. JL Shop employees and volunteers cannot provide donation values, but a blank receipt will be provided for the donor to complete.

## Preparing Your Donation

Clothing should be brought to the Junior League Shop on hangers with sizes clearly marked. The following merchandise should be brought in boxes: toys, jewelry, purses, shoes, baby items, children's clothes through 6X, and household items.

## Drop-off Procedures

Please use the South door of the Shop when making a donation. Donation drop-off is available during regular JL Shop business hours except in December and during Dollar Days, Bag Day, changeover and Spring/Fall Preview when donations are not accepted. If a donor will need assistance with his/her donation, he/she is encouraged to drop-off items between 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. Donors are encouraged to call the JL Shop when making donations after 3 p.m. We encourage donations from non-League members, so please share these guidelines with family and friends.

## Sustainer Pick-Up Services

Although we encourage Sustainers to drop off their own donations, for those who request it, the Junior League Shop will provide pick-up service. This service is available for Sustaining members who reside in Sedgwick County by calling the Junior League Shop Manager at 686-5854. A member of the Shop Committee will then contact you to make arrangements.

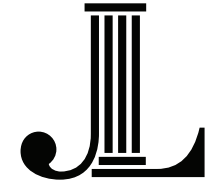

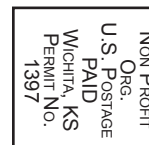

## Standard Value List

The suggested value list for donations is listed below. These guidelines will help you to evaluate your donations for tax purposes.

**GOOD:** Unnoticeable stains, no fading, appears in good shape.

**BETTER:** No stains, looks like it has had minimal wear or looks brand new.

**BEST:** High fashion name, looks like it was never worn. Cleaned and pressed or has original tags still on.

## Acceptability of Consignment Merchandise

Individuals and businesses are welcome to place merchandise on consignment. Below are guidelines to help you determine if your apparel meets the criteria for our Consignment Boutique.

1. Brand name apparel accepted on consignment must be Designer or Better Label clothing. Items must be able to be priced at \$50 or more for formal wear, \$30 or more for suits, coats & dresses, and \$20 or more for separates. All clothing must be in current style, freshly laundered or dry cleaned, on hangers (free of wrinkles), spot & odor free and in good working condition.
2. All accessories must be able to be priced at a minimum of \$15 per item.
3. A consignment contract must be signed by the person leaving articles. You must designate if you want your articles back or if they are a donation if they do not meet criteria or do not sell after 90 days.
4. Consignors will receive forty percent (40%) of the final sales price. Payments will be made quarterly.
5. All consignment merchandise is marked to 1/2 of its original selling price if not sold within 60 days after placement on the sales floor. After 90 days, the merchandise will be considered a donation to the Junior League Shop OR the member/consignor will be contacted and requested to pick-up the merchandise within 7 days.
6. The acceptability and pricing of consignment merchandise will be determined by the Consignment Solicitations Coordinator and her committee or the Shop Manager.

**Fall/Winter clothing accepted between August 1 and January 1.**  
**Spring/Summer clothing accepted between February 1 and June 15.**
